Other Responsibilities and Duties

- Performing General Physical Activities Performing physical activities that require
 considerable use of your arms and legs and moving your whole body, such as climbing, lifting,
 balancing, walking, stooping, and handling of materials.
- **Getting Information** Observing, receiving, and otherwise obtaining information from all relevant sources.
- **Handling and Moving Objects** Using hands and arms in handling, installing, positioning, and moving materials, and manipulating things.
- **Identifying Objects, Actions, and Events** Identifying information by categorizing, estimating, recognising differences or similarities, and detecting changes in circumstances or events.
- Making decisions and solving problems Analysing information and evaluating results to choose the best solution and solve problems.
- **Inspecting equipment, structures, or material** Inspecting equipment, structures, or materials to identify the cause of errors or other problems or defects.
- **Monitor processes, materials, or surroundings** Monitoring and reviewing information from materials, events, or the environment, to detect or assess problems; and
- **Organising, planning, and prioritising work** Developing specific goals and plans to prioritise, organise, to accomplish your work to a high standard.

Skills and Experience

- No previous experience is required in this role.
- A demonstrated interest in plumbing, water operations or other trade work would be an advantage.

Training and Education

- Must hold a valid General Construction Safety Induction (White Card) prior to starting.
- Must hold at least a "C" Class driver's license Learners.
- Must be willing to undertake apprenticeship training, in a combination of on-the-job training and block training. Block training will require travel outside of the Shire and involve being away for multiple weeks.

Reporting Arrangements and Delegations

• This role works directly under the supervision of Council's Senior Plumbers as a part of the Water and Sewerage Team.

- This role is covered by:
