The conference, which focused on regional development and local government, featured notable speakers such as the Hon. Attendees had the opportunity to hear insights from speakers and engage in panel sessions.

Mayor Beresford had the chance to connect with the Hon. Catherine King, Minister for Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development, and Local Government during the ACLG dinner. The Speaker of the House of Representatives, the Hon. Milton Dick, took the opportunity to show the South West Queensland Mayors the Mace, symbolizing his authority in Parliament.

Mayor Beresford and Ms White were grateful for the opportunity to attend the ALGA Conference, which allowed them to gain valuable insights, collaborate with national leaders, and further strengthen Paroo Shire's representation in the local government arena.
