Information relating to the collection of wild dog bounties within the Paroo Shire Council area can be obtained by contacting (07) 4655 8400.

HOW SCALPS ARE TO BE PRESENTED

All scalps will include:-

- a) The strip of hair approximately 100mm in width from the scalp to the tail including the ears and tail
- b) And/or the complete pelt

Note: Photographs of a shot or deceased dog will only be accepted with prior approval from the appropriate Wild Dog Committee Area Representative. The photograph must contain a time stamp to be considered.

INFORMATION CLAIMANT NEEDS TO PROVIDE

1. Completed Wild Dog/Dingo Bounty Claim Form
2. Name of property where the scalp was harvested and property declaration from the Land Owner/Manager or Area Representative including name, address, contact number and signature.
3. Signature of the current Wild Dog Committee Area Representative in which the land is located. If taken there for verification.
4. If multiple scalps are being claimed a detailed account of date and location of where the scalp were harvested must be provided to Rural Lands Officer.
5. Tax Invoice if registered for GST.

Note: Note: Scalps are not to be held/stored by the claimant for a period of longer than three (3) months.

This is to assist us with knowledge of dog movement and reporting purposes.

PAYMENT OF BOUNTIES

Once a completed Wild Dog/Dingo Bounty Claim Form is received payment will be credited to the nominated bank account.
